

Fostering a Safe and Caring Community

Community Partners United (CPU), a San Francisco Parks Trust Partner, is a collaboration of volunteers, community organizations, housing developments, police, business community, neighborhood associations, faith based groups and city agencies that meet on a bi-weekly basis. The group was co-founded in 2002 by Judy Edmond, Northern Safety Network Coordinator, and Richard Johnson, 2002 Hayes Valley Neighborhood Association President. Formerly Hayes Valley Community Partners, over the interceding years the number of participating community partners has continued to grow and broadened both our depth and outreach to neighborhoods like Western Addition. Our mission remains the same: to foster a safe and caring community in the neighborhoods of the Lower Haight, Hayes Valley and Western Addition located in San Francisco.

Mission:

The philosophy of the CPU is to have existing groups collaborate as partners and use their combined resources to find pro-active solutions to crime and violence. Toward that end CPU works very closely with founding partner SFPD Northern District to build a highly respected community policing model. We utilize parks, public spaces, community centers, schools and businesses as safe spaces to bring our diverse community together to share food, fun and entertainment. Our goal is to foster positive interaction and communication among diverse communities so they partner with us to attain a safe and caring community.

Our community sustainability is rooted in the equally beneficial relationship between the partners. Each partner assumes the leadership role of producing one event and all the other partners provide ongoing needed support for each event. A key component of CPU's outreach is to bring our combined community resources to residents and empower them to join us as partners to reduce crime and violence. This involvement has resulted in a yearly calendar of events that take place in schools, parks, churches, community centers, businesses and city hall.

Events:

Each year, for the last eight years, we have ended each year with our "Fostering a Safe and Caring Holiday Season". The season has grown so it now begins in October with Halloween events continues into November with a Thanksgiving event and concludes with a month long schedule of events in December. Since our first season we still strive

to reduce the stress and strain associated with the holidays, in December, on low income families. Last years event included a food basket giveaway to over 250 families, wreath & card making by youth and community, performances by a children's choir, holiday dinner for youth and seniors and participation in the 19^h Annual Hayes Valley December Block Party.

Partners:

CPU founding partners include; Hayes Valley Neighborhood Association, Hayes Valley Playground, CommunityGrows (former Hayes Valley Neighborhood Parks Group), Operation Contact, CREES, Northern District Safety Network, SFPD Northern Police District and Hayes Valley North & South Apartments. Awards:

The CPU has received several commendations, awards and honors for our community policing from Mayor Newsom, Supervisor Mirkarimi and the Board of Supervisors and California State Senator Leno.

All funds raised, minus a 5% administrative fee, go directly into our activities. Administrative support is donated through the work of our committee members.
